



## **GEO™ SOP**

GEO™ VEG is a top feed powder that needs equal parts water and oxygen.

### **How Much to Apply:**

- Start by using one teaspoon the first week.
  - You can start using it as soon as roots are present.
- For container sizes larger than 3" you can move to 2 teaspoons.
- Once you are using a medium, a gallon or more, or if you're using Rockwool but your plants have at least 10 nodes you can start using a tablespoon once a week.

### **Important Facts to Keep in Mind:**

- The powder must remain on top and not be watered out.
  - Maintain a consistent moisture level to continue being active.
- I've found that applying GEO™ after a standard watering is the easiest as it has a high functioning capillary movement and therefore you won't need to do more than maybe hit it with a spray bottle every other day to keep it wet.
- **The goal is to get 30 grams on the plant during its VEG cycle, a tablespoon being about 7 grams.**
- **All of this is for the veg cycle, please don't change anything for your flower cycle. Keep your own SOP for flower and you'll see the results that we have spoken about.**

### **What Not To Use:**

There are a few things that can't be used with this product as they will impede its productivity:

- You cannot use any concentrated amount of humics or fulvics either in the growing medium or as a nutrient regiment.
- You cannot use Silica either, you won't need to as GEO does the same thing when it comes to stem and cell wall strength.
- It is a microbial so it will compete with Mycorrhizal so you cannot use it again as a feed or in the medium.
- If you are using Trichoderma, also known as root shield, that's totally fine.
